Basic Competency Requirement for Formal Admission to Alternate Program/Education Department (one of the following):

- Praxis I: Reading (176), Writing (172) Math (175) OR
- Praxis I (Reading, Writing, Math) Composite Score = 527 OR
- ACT (Math, Reading, Grammar, Science) Composite Score = 24 OR
- SAT (Critical Reading + Math) Score = 1100 OR
- GRE (Verbal + Quantitative) Score = 1100 OR
- Master's Degree
